- Buys compact fluorescent lightbulbs for an entire house, reducing a low-income family's energy use. *Project Home (photo at right)*



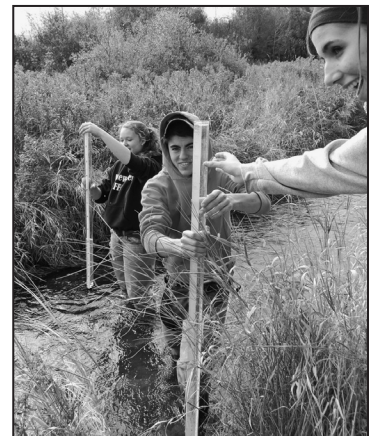
Your gift of **\$5 a month or \$60 per year:**
