

Powerful, Responsive Collaboration on the Front Lines of Social and Environmental Justice Advocacy: *Community Shares of Wisconsin Member Groups Make An Impact*

Economic Justice: *Voces de la Frontera* is speaking up for immigrant farm and factory workers with increased workplace safety measures in food processing plants for these critical, vulnerable workers.



Racial Education: *NAACP of Dane County* and *Kids Forward* have helped us understand that because of systemic racism, our Black community has always had dramatically disparate health and education outcomes. The impacts of COVID-19 are exacerbating these disparities.



Safety: *End Domestic Abuse Wisconsin*, *Rape Crisis Center*, and *UNIDOS* are working against increased risk of domestic violence while people are forced to shelter at home with their abusers through counseling, education, & advocacy.

Health Equity: *Rebalanced-Life Wellness Association* and *ABC for Health* are working to assist those whose access to health care is threatened by layoffs.

Prison Reform: Groups like the *ACLU of Wisconsin* and *MOSES-WISDOM of Madison* are leading efforts to reduce the spread of the pandemic in our jails by advocating for the release of elderly and vulnerable prison populations.



Police Violence: After years of organizing and Black Lives Matter protests, *Freedom, Inc.* and the *Dane County TimeBank's* campaign to remove police from schools was successful and has shifted the debate around policing to a more anti-racist definition of safety and justice.



Environmental Health: *Midwest Environmental Advocates*, *River Alliance of Wisconsin*, *Wisconsin Conservation Voices*, and *Clean Wisconsin* are implementing public education and legislative advocacy to address PFAS, chemicals contaminating wells and drinking water across the state.

Food Security: *REAP Food Group* partnered with *Rooted* to launch the Farms to Families Fund working with regional family farms impacted by the loss of wholesale customers to bring fresh, healthy, locally grown food to Madison-area Latino and Indigenous residents hard-hit by pandemic job loss, food insecurity, & anti-immigration provisions.

Housing: *Legal Action of Wisconsin* pushed for a temporary ban on evictions, and *Tenant Resource Center* and *Fair Housing Center of Greater Madison* provided emergency advocacy to tenants.
